It is likely that you will have picked up via the media that Powys County Council is embarking on a review of its provision for secondary education based on a vision that Powys offers "*the highest quality bilingual learning provision with a broad range of learning opportunities, supported by world class facilities and technology that will enable all Powys learners to develop their skills to the highest level*".

Secondary schools in Powys deliver a high quality education for learners as demonstrated by the consistently high examination results. There are a number of factors that are threatening the success of our Secondary schools and there is a danger of schools failing to meet the minimum curriculum legislative requirements. It is the case that Powys County Council has started a review of how best to organise and deliver secondary education and has begun to consider a number of models that are outlined within a Strategic Outline Programme.

The purpose of this letter is to assure you that there are no proposals at this stage to close any secondary schools nor their sixth forms. I also want to assure you that no decisions have been made nor will be made
